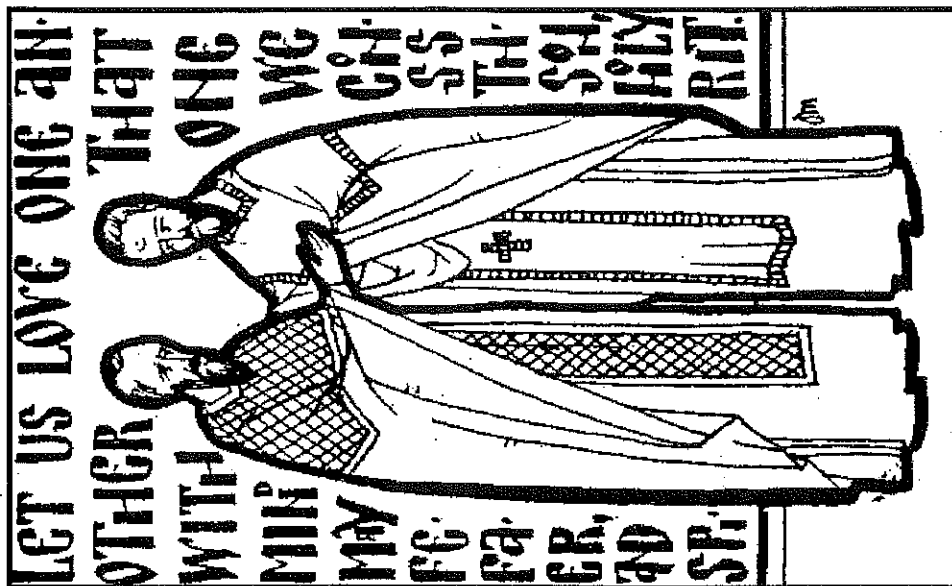

**FROM PITTSBURGH:**

Take ROUTE 65 NORTH to McKees Rocks Bridge.  
Take HELEN STREET exit ramp off bridge,

TURN LEFT at the bottom of exit onto Helen Street. At first stop sign, TURN RIGHT onto ELLA STREET. At next stop sign, TURN RIGHT onto MUNSON AVENUE. The Church is on the RIGHT.

**FROM THE SOUTH**

Take ROUTE 51 NORTH to McKees Rocks.  
TURN RIGHT onto McKees Rocks Bridge from Route 51.

Take HELEN STREET exit ramp off bridge,  
TURN RIGHT at the bottom of exit onto Helen Street. At first stop sign, TURN RIGHT onto ELLA STREET. At the next stop sign, TURN RIGHT onto MUNSON AVENUE. The Church is on the RIGHT.

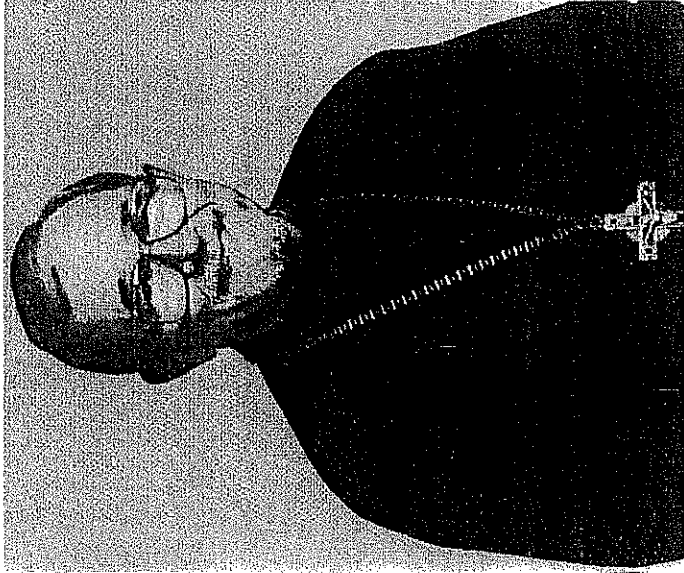
